Tasting Notes:

A delightful red table wine blended from Pinot Noir (44%), Cabernet Franc (37%), and Gamay Noir (19%). Ruby in color, with a nose that exhibits red fruits, light herbs, and a touch of cedar oak. The wine is medium bodied with light tannins and red fruits and a hint of earthiness and oak in the finish.

Winemaker Notes:

The grapes were harvested in October 2008: with Gamay on the 6th, Pinot Noir on the 8th, and Cabernet Franc on the 30th. Good ripeness was achieved and ranged from 21.5 Brix (Gamay & Pinot Noir) to 23 Brix (Cabernet Franc). Yeast included D254 and BM45. All lots were pressed at dryness and racked into older, neutral barrels.

This is a popular house red wine for everyday meals, including pastas, pizza and burgers.
